Current research of the group deals, for example, with the question of how the use of professional social network sites leads to new ideas and informational benefits. Other topics are the smartphone use of mothers for stress coping or informal learning with YouTube videos.

Your task will be to develop an independent research profile (preferably on the topic of knowledge-related media use in the family), to publish at a high level and to attract competitive third-party funding. In addition, you will be involved in the supervision of (doctoral) students and support the administrative management of the junior research group.
